The USA is the most diverse and dynamic economy on earth and employers are eager to introduce international trainees to their workplace. You'll gain front line experience, learn about the latest developments in your field, and make valuable career contacts. All of which add up to an important boost in your career credentials.

Internship USA is a unique program for full-time students and recent graduates which allows you to work in the US, in a job related to your field of studies, for up to 12 months. You can apply and go at any time of the year.

It is a chance to put your studies into practice, enhance your skills, and learn about American business culture from the inside.

Eligibility

- You must be over 18 years old and:
- ✓ hold HSC or equivalent
 - ✓ be a full-time student enrolled at a university, TAFE or Polytechnic college in Australia or New Zealand (minimum Diploma level course of 2 years duration)
 - ✓ no part-time students can be accepted
 - ✓ must have completed the first 12 months of studies
 - ✓ must commence your training or have graduated from such an institution no more than 12 months prior to your prospective program start date.
 - ✓ have fluent spoken and written English skills

International students are eligible to apply but the granting of visas is at the discretion of the US consulate.

Trainee USA is a program that offers non-students, graduates and young professionals the unique opportunity to gain international training in the USA.

US employers are eager to introduce international trainees, who often bring fresh ideas and new perspectives, to the workplace. You too will make valuable contacts, learn about the latest developments in your field and gain firsthand insight into American business culture.

Eligibility

You must be between 20 and 40 years old and;

- ✓ hold HSC or equivalent
- ✓ be a graduate of a post-secondary institution with at least 1 year of prior related professional experience outside the US or have 5 years of prior related practical experience
- ✓ have fluent spoken and written English skills
- ✓ have an Australian or New Zealand Passport



Finding a Job

This process can be daunting and you may receive a few knock-backs but if you follow a few helpful steps it will make the process a lot easier. Here are some useful ways you can get started:

- Utilise Placement Officers, Careers Advisors and personal contacts, which often provide the hottest job leads.

How to Apply

Step 1 - Download all the available information from our website to learn more about the program, or contact us directly to discuss our programs further.

Step 2 - Start your job search using the resources we make available.

Step 3 - When you have accepted an offer from a US employer, complete the application forms: Internship or Trainee USA application form. Get your Host Company to complete an Internship or Trainee DS-7002.

Step 4 - Return these documents to us along with your \$250 deposit.
